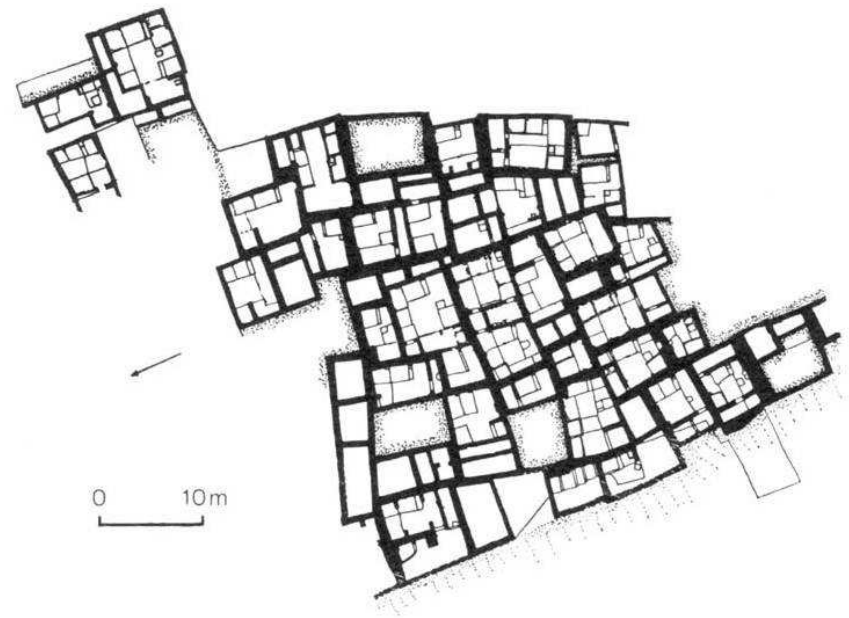
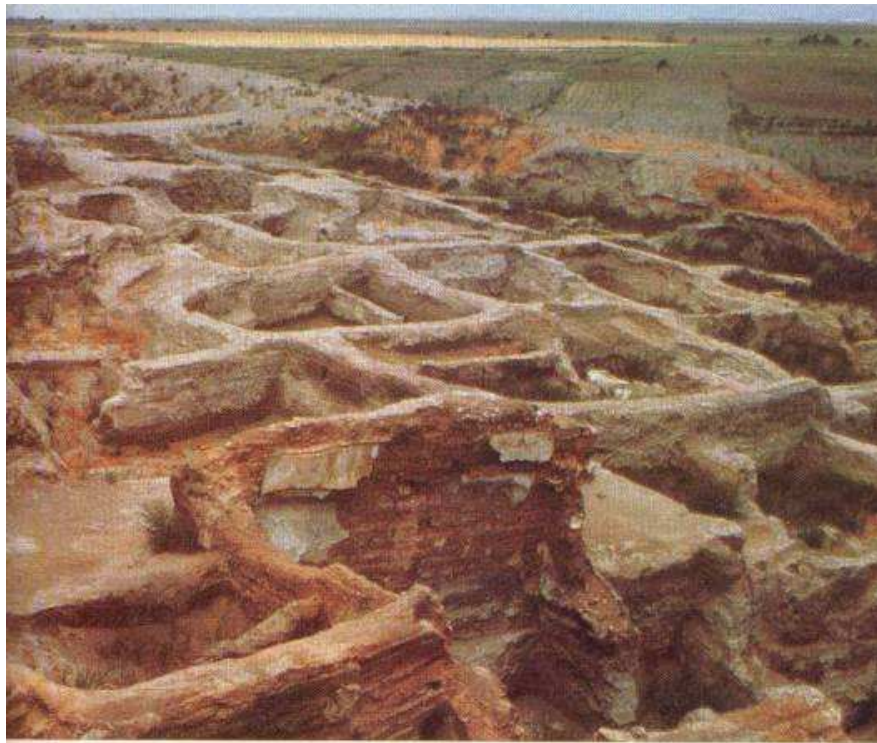
# Archetypes
